Project Challenges:

Neighbouring buildings and community coordination; noise pollution.

Hand demolition to maintain façade for incorporation into community centre building in the area.



Project Description:

Demolition of the former Cults Parish Church along with a nursery, church hall, manse and neighbouring house. This project was carried out for Church of Scotland and McCarthy Stone to clear the site for a community centre and retirement homes.

The granite church tower and spire were demolished by hand with key elements of the façade numbered and palletised for incorporation into the community centre building.



Key Works:

Hand Removal of façade for incorporation into community centre building in the area.

Complete foul and storm drainage network including enabling drainage to facilitate construction operations.
